Give careful attention to each part of the module:

Opening statement

Module outline

Module objectives

Instructions (if any)

The module objectives show what you can accomplish and know by a certain point in the study. Aim to achieve each objective before proceeding to the next one.

Interspersed throughout the module are study questions designed to test you on the part of the module you've just completed. Answer all questions and reflect or discuss as appropriate. If you formulate your own answers, you will retain what you study much better. Do not look ahead to the answers we have provided until you have given yours. Correct any incorrect answers. Review the text if there is anything you do not understand.

COPING WITH THE COURSE

Studying by distance learning may seem relatively straightforward as one is not restricted to an academic term or fixed lecture times. However, it can be much harder as the distance learner does not have the benefit of a regular college schedule. He or she must create that themselves and have the discipline to stick to it.

Each module will take between 6-10 hours to complete. It is, therefore, important to plan your study time and set realistic targets taking other commitments into account. It is better to study in short, frequent sessions than over long, infrequent periods. For example, an hour-long session, twice a week, is ample. In that way, your momentum will be consistently maintained. Our modules are usually divided into manageable portions of smaller sections. Even if you only have 30 minutes to spare, you can probably manage a subsection and have a sense of achievement and forward progress.

Your MOSAIC tutor will be happy to advise you on any difficulty you may face with the module.

CREDITS FOR THIS COURSE

To obtain credits for this module, you must submit an Assessment which tests your knowledge of the entire module.
